FP7 PEOPLE Marie Curie Actions

- **Objective: attract/retain numerous, well-trained, motivated researchers in Europe**
- **Development of adequate and broad skills for both the private and public sector**
- **Sustainable career development**
- **Increased private sector participation**
- **Strengthened international dimension**
- **No thematic priorities**
- **Balanced gender objective**
- **Experience criterion instead of age limit**

Marie Curie Action: IRSES

IRSES - International Research Staff Exchange Scheme

Aim of the action:

Strengthening research partnerships through staff exchanges and networking activities between:

European research organisations

and organisations from countries, which have signed an S&T agreement with the Community or are in the process of negotiating a one, and countries covered by the European Neighbourhood Policy.



Marie Curie Actions: IRSES

- **Network: at least 2 organisations of Member States and Associated + at least 1 Third Country organisation**
- **financial support for a period of 24 to 48 months**
- **joint programmes for short exchanges of research staff (both ways)**
- **may include technical and management staff**
- **duration of exchanges for each researcher: max.12 months**
- **a subsistence allowance of outgoing European researchers: 1800EUR/researcher/month**

Marie Curie Action: IIF

IIF: International Incoming Fellowships

Aim of the action:

Reinforcement of scientific excellence of the Member States and the Associated countries through **knowledge sharing with incoming top-class researchers from *third countries***

to work on research projects in Europe, with the view on developing mutually-beneficial research co-operation between Europe and *third countries*.



Marie Curie Actions: IIF

- Action is addressed to the **experienced researchers** (doctorate or >4 years of research experience) **active in a third country**
- Researcher applies in liaison with a legal entity ('host organization') in EU Member State or Associated country
- Project (**1-3 years**) may consist of two phases: 1) in EU or Associated country (1 - 2 years) and 2) possible return phase in a country of origin
- **Applicants can be of any nationality.** They must move from a *third country* to a Member State or Associated country
- Researchers must not have resided in the country of their 'host organisation' for more than 12 month in the 3 years immediately prior to the date of deadline

IOF - International Outgoing Fellowships

Aim of the action:

Enhancement of the European researches' career with international dimension by providing the opportunity to be **trained and acquire new knowledge in a *third country* high-level research organisation.**

These researchers will return with the knowledge and experience gained in *third country* to an organisation in a Member State or Associated country.



Marie Curie Action: IOF

- Action is addressed to the **experienced researchers** (doctorate or >4 years of research experience)
- Researcher applies in liaison with a legal entity ('return host organization') in EU Member State or Associated country
- Project (**2-3 years**) consists of two phases: 1) in *third country* (1 - 2 years) and 2) obligatory return phase in a EU Member State or Associated Country
- Applicants must be nationals of a Member State or Associated Country
- Researchers must not have resided in the country of their 'host organisation' for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to the date of deadline

Marie Curie Action: ITN

ITN - Initial Training Network

Aim of the action:

Supporting the initial training of researchers, typically directed at the first five years of researchers' careers.

The action is being implemented through support to competitively selected trans-national networks (Marie Curie Networks) of complementary organisations from different countries, both public and private, engaged in research training.



Marie Curie Action: ITN

Network: at least 3 different Member States or Associated Countries

Community support under this action will comprise:

- the recruitment of early-stage researchers to be trained;
- the possibility for setting up academic chairs, or equivalent positions in enterprises, for experienced researchers, with a view to transferring new knowledge and strengthening supervision;
- the organization of short training events (conferences, specialized training courses), open to both trainees of the network and to researchers from outside the network.
- **Early-Stage Researchers** apply directly to the 'host institution' in answer to the vacancies published on the following website:




