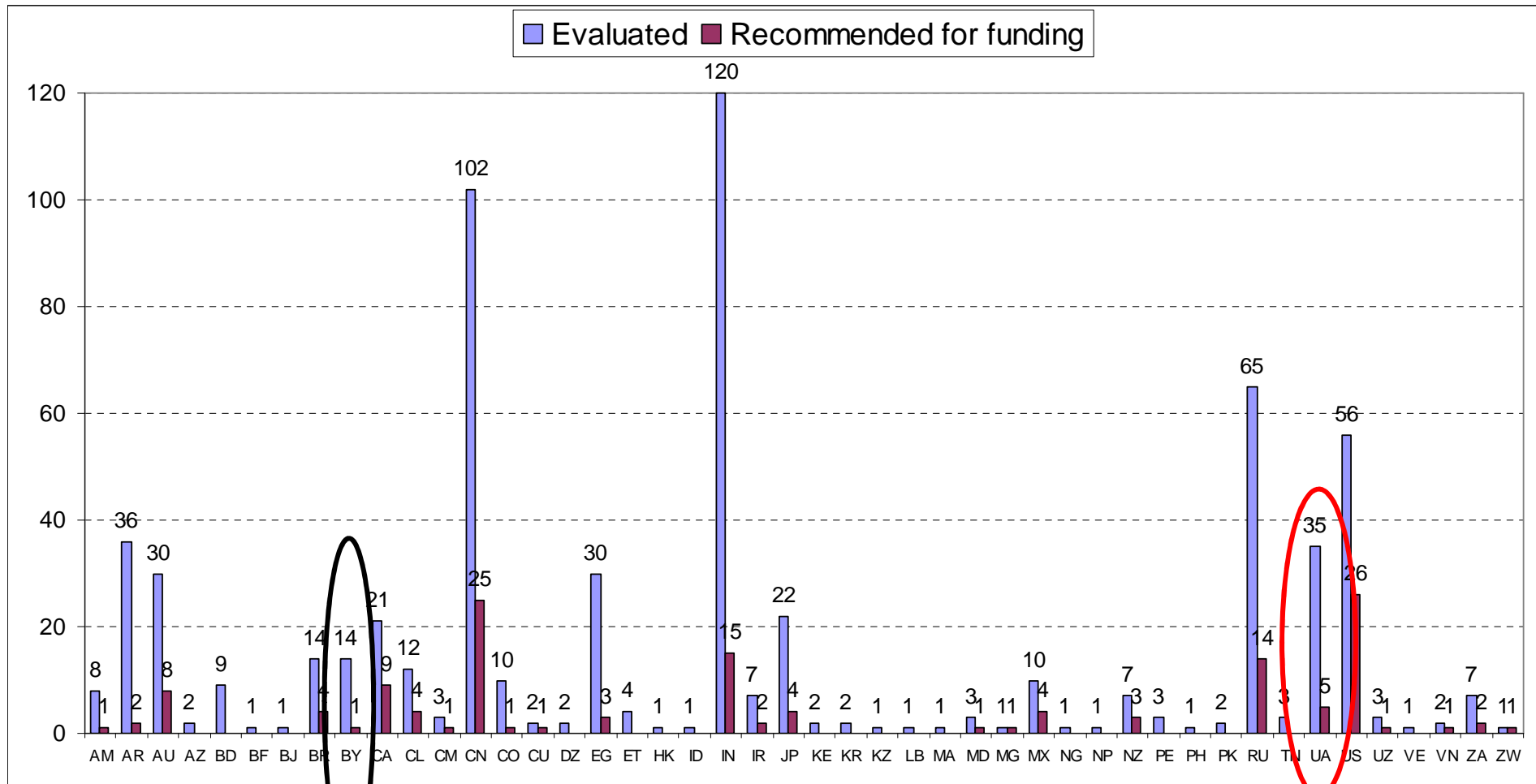

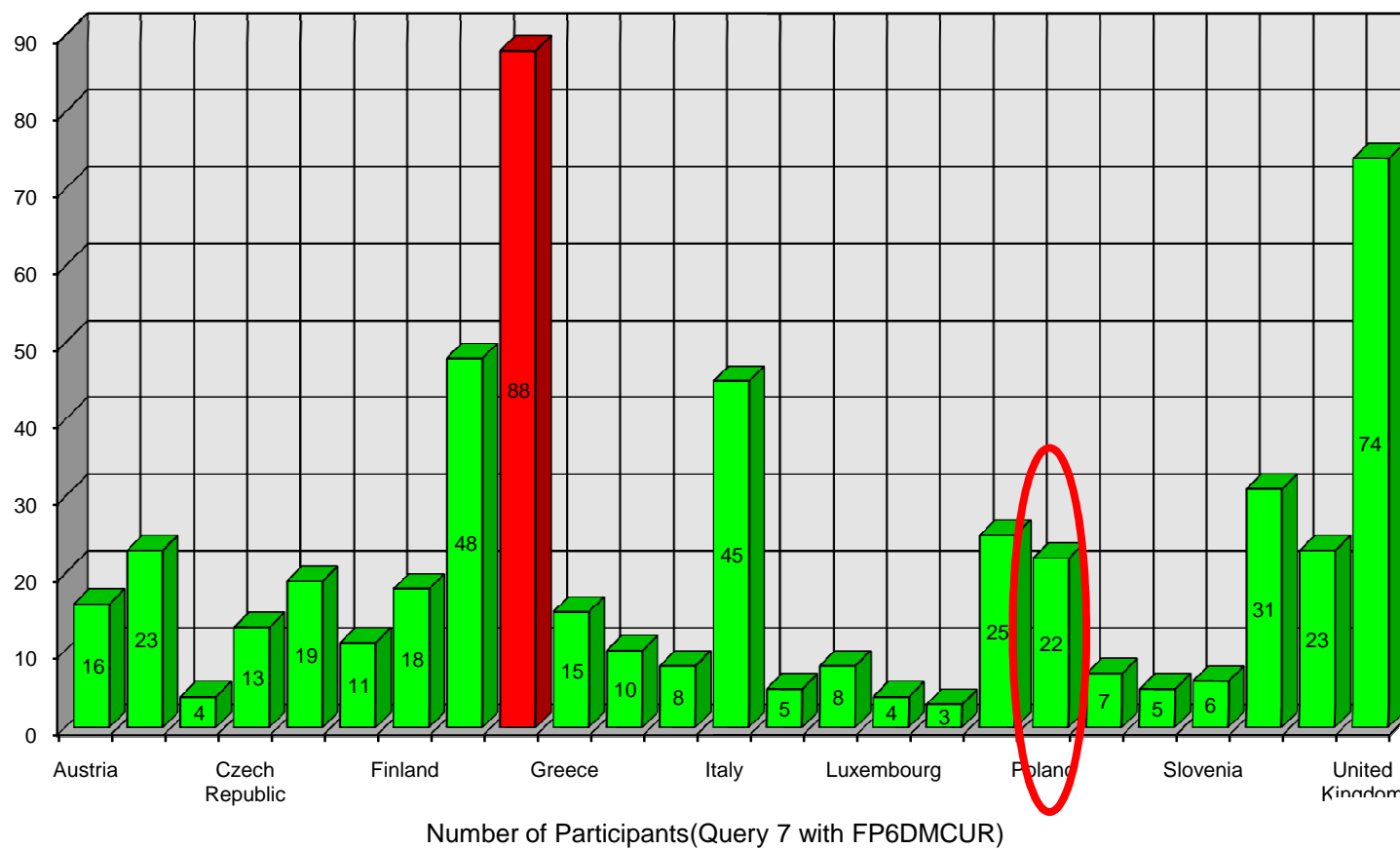

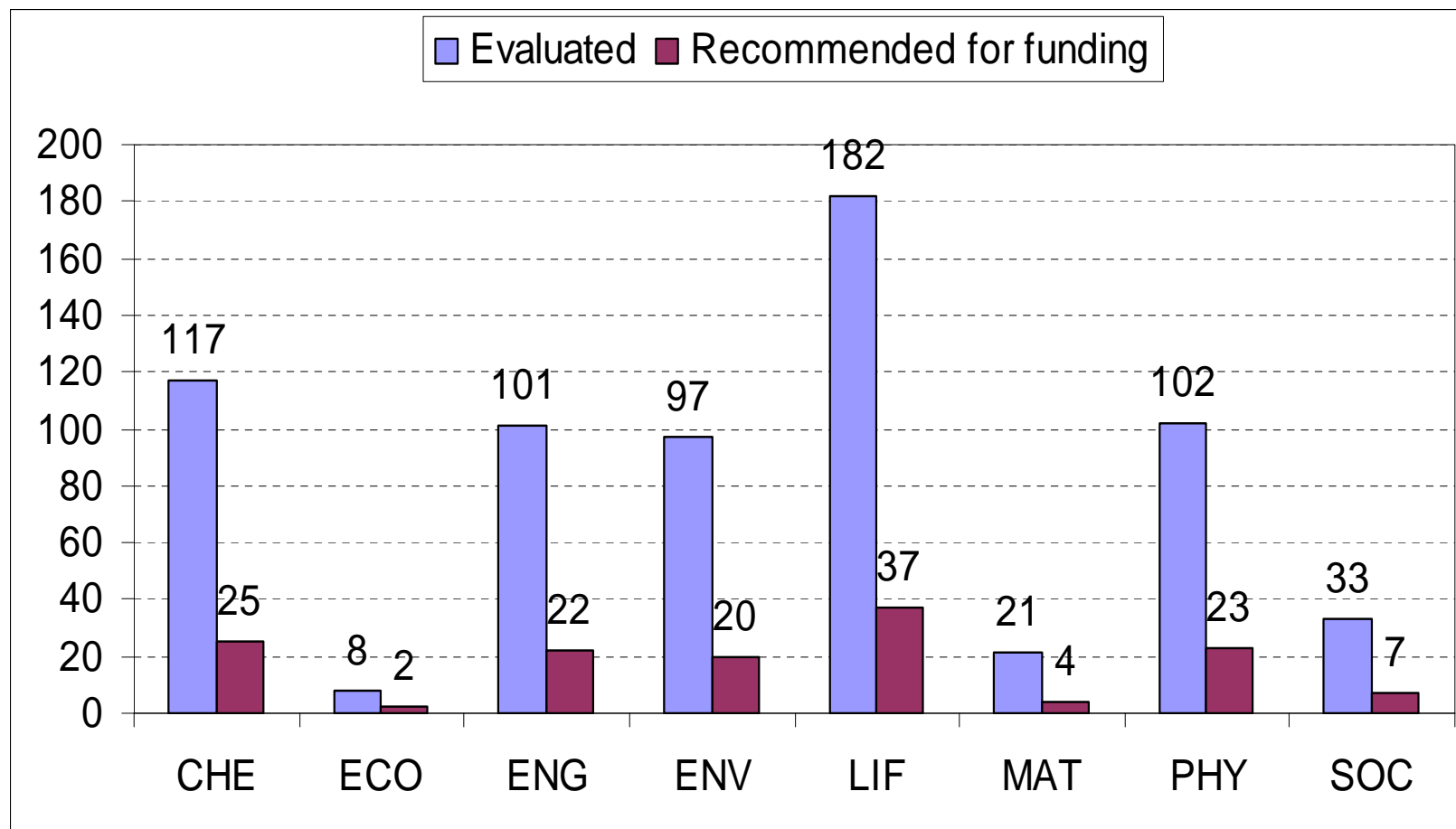
IIFs 2008 - Results by nationality of applicant

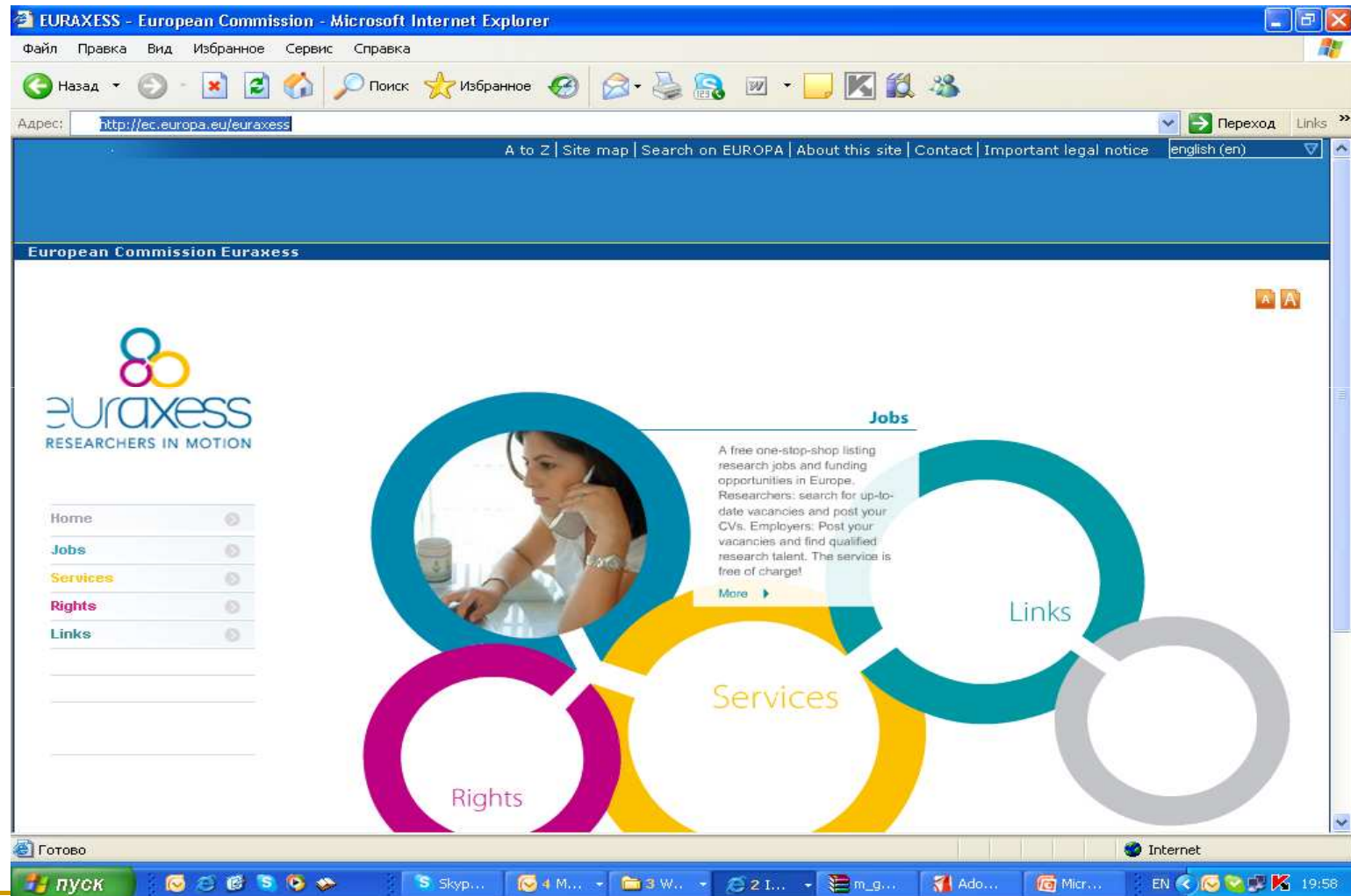

About IncoNet EECA

The partnership between the countries of the European Union and Eastern Europe/Central Asia (EECA) is of utmost importance for the political, economic and social development of both regions. Linking the scientific potential and resources has a huge impact on economic growth, social prosperity and welfare as well as public stability. The EU and EECA countries have significant potentials both in terms of the strong academic community and of worldwide leading S&T institutes in a variety of scientific disciplines.

In order to make optimum use of each others academic strengths, to share respective resources and to prepare the ground for a joint transfer of academic results to national, regional and worldwide markets there is a strong bi-regional interest in enhancing S&T cooperation. Although the S&T cooperation between the EU Member States, Associated Countries and the EECA partner countries is quite developed, there is still much room for its further development addressing each others priorities as well as global challenges and building on national, bilateral and Community instruments. The IncoNet EECA project will facilitate a coordination of S&T policies building on common interest and aiming at mutual benefit in order to strengthen the cooperation between EU and EECA.

The **main objectives** of IncoNet EECA are:

- To support and facilitate a bi-regional EU – EECA S&T policy dialogue and, in the case of Russia and the Ukraine, a complementary bilateral S&T policy dialogue involving stakeholders from policy making, science community and industry. Направление «Люди» (People)

30 ноября 2007 года в программе «Люди» объявлен новый конкурс **"Международный обмен научными кадрами" (International Research Staff Exchange Scheme)**

Новый конкурс по программе «Люди» Седьмой рамочной программы направлен на усиление научно-технического сотрудничества со странами, не входящими в Европейский Союз, в рамках подписанных соглашений о научно-техническом сотрудничестве или Европейской программы добрососедства.

Данное направление по обмену научными кадрами предназначено для развития научно-исследовательских партнерств между научными организациями.

Это направление основывается на совместных программах, с обязательным предоставлением средств как со стороны ЕС и ассоциированных стран, так и третьих стран (не входящих в состав ЕС).

Научные организации из следующих стран могут принимать участие:

1) Страны, подписавшие Соглашение о научно-техническом сотрудничестве с ЕС: Аргентина*, Австралия, Бразилия*, Канада, Китай*, Чили*, Египет*, Индия*, Япония, Южная Корея, Мексика*, Марокко*, Новая Зеландия, Россия*, ЮАР*, Тунис*, Украина*, США.

2) Страны, входящие в Европейскую программу добрососедства:

- страны Восточной Европы и Центральной Азии (EECA): Армения*, Азербайджан*, Беларусь*, Грузия*, Молдова*, Украина*;
- средиземноморские страны (MCP): Алжир*, Египет*, Иордан*, Ливан*, Ливия*, Марокко*, Палестина*, Сирия*, Тунис*.

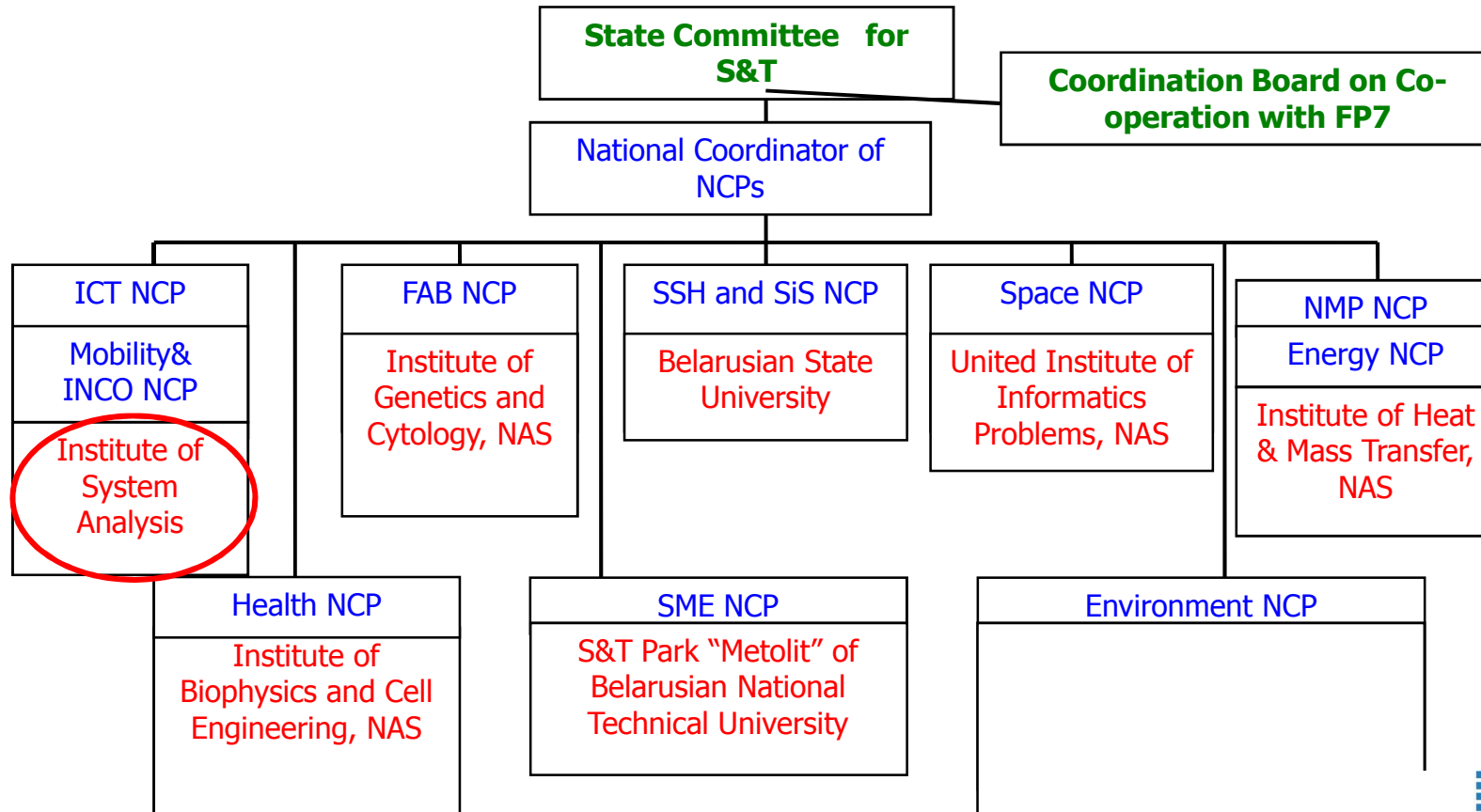
Заявка может подаваться консорциумом, состоящим из 2 научных организаций из двух различных стран ЕС или ассоциированных стран и одной или нескольких научных организаций из страны, не входящей в состав ЕС.

Координатором проекта выступает европейская научная организация. Продолжительность проекта 2-4 года.

Цель проекта: организация краткосрочных (до 12 месяцев) командировок в рамках обмена кадрами в любой научной области. В командировку могут направляться научные сотрудники, административный и технический персонал организаций-партнеров.

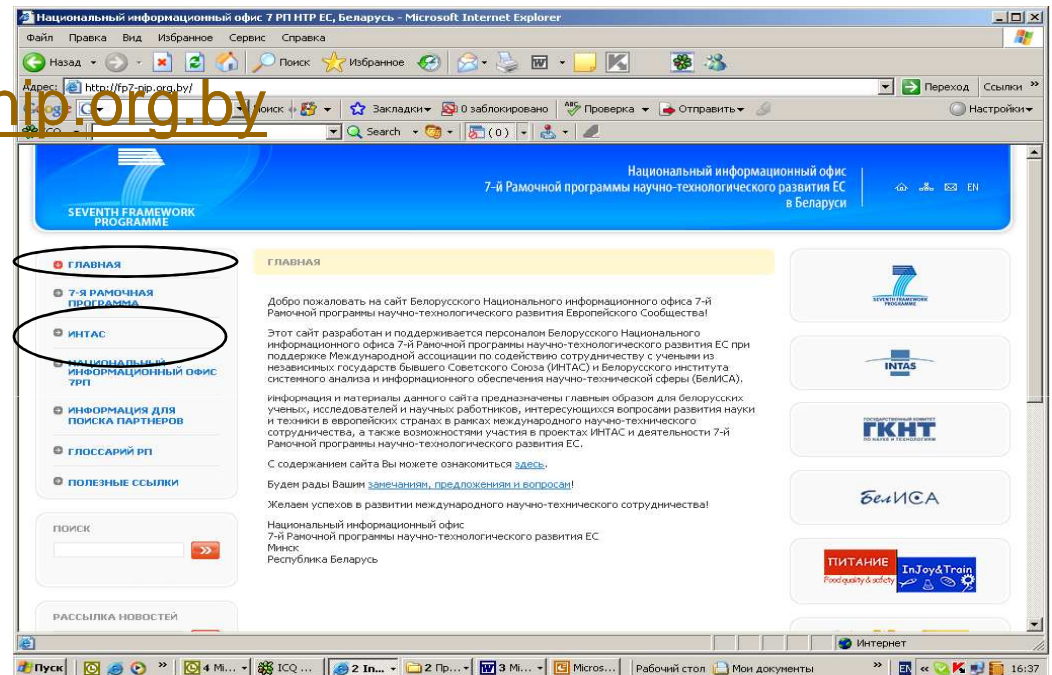
